If you wish to register for an appointment and participate in a webinar, you will be redirected to the Clickmeeting website. To use this service, you must register with Clickmeeting. To register, Clickmeeting may collect the following information from you: First name, last name, email address, city, address, postcode, company/organization and optionally job title and number of employees.

Any collection or processing done here by Clickmeeting is the responsibility of Clickmeeting. Clickmeeting Privacy Policy. Up to this point, Clickmeeting is the responsible party in terms of data protection law.

Following this registration, Clickmeeting will transmit this information to Audimus to facilitate the online seminars. The responsible party for these online seminars is Audimus Consulting GmbH, Berliner Promenade 5, 66111 Saarbrücken.

If Audimus uses other third parties to provide the services offered, Audimus is entitled to pass on your data to them insofar as this is necessary for the technical administration and maintenance of Audimus products. Audimus will provide up-to-date information on this in its privacy policy.

1. Purpose

Audimus receives the following information from you:

First name, last name, email address, city, address, postcode, company/organization and optionally job title and number of employees.

The personally identifiable information (PII) you provide is processed for the following purposes:

- **As part of the webinar, you agree to receive offers of interest from Audimus at any time by e-mail or telephone. This consent can be revoked at any time, with effect for the future.**

2. Inadmissible content

You are solely responsible for the content you send to us as part of the online seminars. Please ensure that you do not send us any file attachments containing viruses or worms. The information you send us must be truthful, must not violate any third-party rights, public law regulations or morality ("Unacceptable Content").

Please also note that you will indemnify us against any claims that we may have because of information containing Prohibited Content that you submit to us.

3. With whom will personal data be shared?

Audimus will never sell or otherwise transfer your data to third parties for a fee, but we reserve the right to transfer your personal data and information that you provide as part of the online seminars to other companies in the Audimus Group, which may include transfer to countries outside the EU. You consent to the use of your data for the intended purpose by the Audimus group companies, in particular the group companies in your country.
